

Gal d 3 (Conalbumin; non recombinant)

Allergen Specification

Product Number: 53400

Description:

Gallus domesticus Gal d 3, also known as Conalbumin.

Native allergen for in vitro research and manufacturing use only.

Immunological function:

Binds IgE-type human antibodies.

Origin:

Native. Purified from egg white by protein-chemical methods.

Biochemical tests:

SDS-PAGE (purity > 80%); Western blot with patient sample.

Endotoxin content:

Tested by LAL (Limulus Amoebocyte Lysate) chromogenic endotoxin assay.

Immunological tests/Functionality:

Immunodot analyses with positive/negative samples.

Recommended buffer/storage and handling conditions:

Recommendations for storage buffer: neutral to slightly alkaline pH and 20% glycerol as cryoprotective agent.

Storage conditions: -70°C or below.

Repeated freeze/thaw cycles should be avoided.
